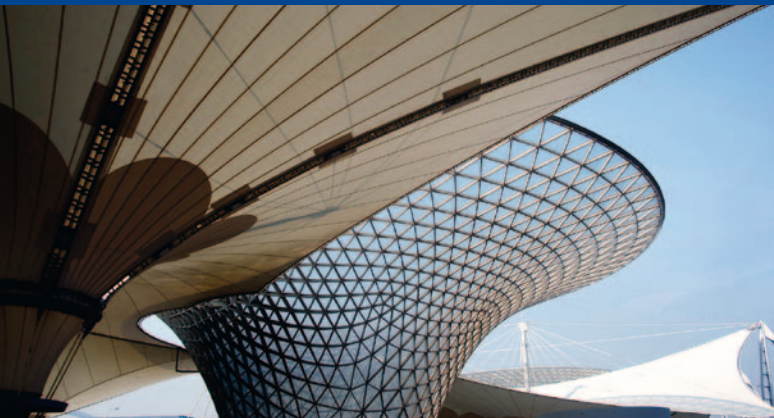


Congress Site Shanghai
